

Overview

Many conferences present Climate Threats as separate from Dual-Use challenges. In addition, most people assume that data security, redundancy and sharing between communities and international organizations exist. This is not the case in the Indo-Pacific region where natural and man-made disasters and conflict disrupt data and cripple critical infrastructure.

A Whole-of-Society approach is required to address data security in the midst of disasters and conflict.

This event address the whys and hows - to jumpstart coordination between Allied Nations. Speakers will address whole-of-society data sharing, data security of initial sources and across data classifications. Subject matter experts on Pacific Island Nations and other regions experiencing these threats will highlight the need for emerging capabilities in data collection platforms and data synthesis.

Participants are encouraged to bring data sets and use cases to the conference addressing man-made and natural disasters, climate threats and conflict.


